The Statistics major requires 24 credits at the 2000-level or above in statistics and must include STAT 3375Q and 3445. Since STAT 3375Q has MATH 2110Q or 2130Q as a prerequisite, students should begin the calculus sequence as soon as possible. A grade of C+ or better in MATH 2110Q or 2130Q is required as a prerequisite for this course. Please note that neither STAT 1000Q nor STAT 1100Q will count towards the 24 required major credits. STAT 3494W also will not count towards the 24 required major credits but is required for the major.

Math and a combination of other "quantitatively oriented" courses in Biology, Business, Economics, Geography, Psychological Sciences, Sociology, etc. may be accepted as Related Courses. The student must get the faculty advisor's approval for any such courses to be used as Related Courses. Related
